Books:

- Fantastic Mr Fox
- The Firework Maker's Daughter

English: During reading lessons this term, the children will pocus on 'Fantastic Mr Fox' by Roald Dahl and 'The Firework Maker's Daughter' by Philip Pullman. We will continue to consolidate and build on, learnt reading skills such as retrieval and incerence. This will also allow us to link our reading to our writing, with children looking at how authors use language, presentation and writing structure to enhance meaning. Handwriting and grammar will also be a pocus, with children practising discretely, in all areas of written work, not just in English lessons. In writing lessons, we will be pocusing on developing our skills in writing character descriptions of Mr Fox, newspaper reporting and diary entries. Whilst studying The Firework Maker's Daughter we will pocus on the genres of letter writing and narrative. Spellings will be tested on a Wednesday.

Malhematics: Malhs this term begins with recognising, identifying and representing 3-digit numbers using different resources and methods. We will pocus on the place value of each digit (hundreds, tens, ones) so that we can compare and order numbers up to 1,000, using the vocabulary of 'greater than' and 'less than'. Following this, we will pocus on addition and subtraction using the pormal, written (column) method. We will begin to estimate our answers and use the inverse operation to check. Finally, there will be a pocus on embedding knowledge of the 2,5 and 10 times tables whilst there will also be a greater emphasis on learning to multiply and divide by 3, 4 and 8. Science: in science this term we will learn all about our bodies. We will consider bones, muscles, movement and nutrition. We will then pocus on Forces and Magnets before Christmas.

Computing: in computing we will begin with a pocus on e-sapety, thinking about peelings, sharing and how to be sape online. We will then begin to learn about coding, including algorithms.

History: in History we will be comparing life in the Stone, Bronze and Iron Ages, thinking about the events and artepacts which had the greatest impact on the historical changes.

Geography: in Geography we will be looking at areas of natural geography, including the structure of the Earth, whilst answering the enquiry question:
Why do people live by volcanoes?

Music: in Music we will have whole-class violin lessons with the DPA. The children will learn different notes, scales and ways of playing before performing at the end of the year.

PE: in P.E. we will begin with a multi-skills pocus, specifically looking at balance and agility. We will also learn swimming skills at Summerhill on a Wednesday morning.

RE: in R.E. we will begin the berm by exploring the impact worship and pestivals have in the lipe of Muslims. We will pinish the term by exploring Christianity and the concept of the Trinity.

PSHE: in PSHE we will be pocusing on building and maintaining healthy priendships. We will then pocus on health and wellbeing, learning how to maintain our physical and mental health.

Art/D&T: in art we will be pocusing on the thread of drawing, designing our own characters. In D&T we will use construction skills to build model castles.
